

Conflict Minerals Statement – Jonal Laboratories Inc.

Jonal Laboratories is committed to responsible sourcing and to conducting business in a manner that respects human rights, ethics, and environmental stewardship. We support global efforts to eliminate the use of conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

This statement applies to products manufactured, contracted, or distributed by **Jonal Laboratories** that may contain tantalum, tin, tungsten, or gold (“3TG”). Jonal Laboratories does not knowingly source conflict minerals that fund armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries and expects its suppliers to share this commitment.

Jonal Laboratories supports the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas and, where applicable, U.S. SEC Rule 13p-1. As part of its due diligence efforts, Jonal Laboratories conducts reasonable country-of-origin inquiries, requests relevant suppliers to complete the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT), and reviews responses for completeness and consistency. Suppliers are encouraged to source 3TG from smelters and refiners validated through the RMI Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) or equivalent programs.

Suppliers are expected to maintain responsible sourcing policies, provide accurate and timely conflict minerals information upon request, cascade these expectations through their supply chains, and take corrective actions when non-conformant smelters or refiners are identified.

Jonal Laboratories recognizes that conflict minerals due diligence is an ongoing process and is committed to continuous improvement through supplier engagement and alignment with industry best practices.
